He was just like you, a normal kid, who played on the basketball team and served as student body president at Holy Savior Menard Central High School in Alexandria, Louisiana.

The scholarship was established to honor his values and life along with all the brave men and women of the Alexandria Fire Department.

The Brian Whaley Scholarship is awarded annually to two graduating seniors or current college students who are the children of a current or former member of the Alexandria, LA, Pineville, LA., Rapides Parish Fire District Number 2, or East Baton Rouge fire departments.
